Message Title: The Common Thread

Scripture: John 17:20-23, 1 Corinthians 13:13, 1 Corinthians 15:3-8, Romans 14:5-9, Romans 14:10-19, Ephesians 4:1-3, 1 John 3:14, 1 John 3:18-19, John 3:16
