Sermon Title: The Counter-cultural King

Scripture: John 4:5-15, Philippians 4:5-13, Philippians 4:8

Theme: Generally speaking, kindness is received with skepticism these days. Sometimes though, when we are the recipient of something as counter-cultural as a random act of love...it fills us with delight and a sense of wonder. When people act like Jesus...the world takes notice.
